



ICF International Awarded \$6 Million Contract with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency

FAIRFAX, Va.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Feb. 28, 2012-- ICF International (NASDAQ:ICFI), a leading provider of consulting services and technology solutions to government and commercial clients, has been awarded a re-compete contract by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to support its efforts to remove barriers to clean energy investments by clean energy program administrators, including investor-, publicly-, or cooperatively-owned utilities; municipals; cooperatives; state and local governments; third-party administrators; and other key stakeholders. The contract has a value of \$6 million and a term of one base year and four option years.

Under the contract, ICF will work with five EPA initiatives—ENERGY STAR® Program, State and Local Climate and Energy Program, State and Utility Regulation and Clean Energy efforts, Green Power Partnership, and Combined Heat and Power Partnership—to develop a portfolio of cost-effective clean energy solutions across residential, commercial, industrial, and municipal sectors.
